

Manual to the rehabilitation robot

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Usage without computer

- Plug the power cable in the outlet
- The screen will indicate the start-up
- There are 2 buttons underneath the screen, with those you can adjust the level

- The levels indicate a certain force the user needs to apply

- Pull the handle, and watch the screen indicate off how far you are.
- If you pull the handle far enough the program will adjust the counter +1.
- If you want to reset the counter you need to push the 2 buttons underneath the screen simultaneously for 5 seconds.

Usage with computer

- Plug-in the USB cable in your computer
- Install the program included in the package
- Move the robot; you should see the mouse moving
- The revalidation robot is now a mouse for your computer
- The pulling handle is the left mouse button
- The little button near your thumb is the right mouse button
- Work, play,... whatever you want with your computer, and watch the counter rise trough the roof!
